### Amendment

1. Closures of two BNSF crossing in South Sioux City including 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and 30<sup>th</sup> Street, with signal upgrades at C Street and Dakota Avenue need to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$117,000 with \$100,000 Federal participation (Federal Rail Safety Section 130 Funding) in FY 2011 and \$117,000 total estimated cost with \$100,000 in Federal participation in FY 2012

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Administrative Modification

1. Interstate 29 Reconstruction (Iowa DOT) in Sioux City needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$33,237,000 with \$29,913,000 Federal participation in FY 2011; \$38,716,000 with \$34,844,000 Federal participation in FY 2012; \$35,798,000 with \$32,218,000 Federal participation in FY 2013, and \$77,972,000 with \$70,175,000 Federal participation in FY 2014

- IX. FY 2011 – 2014 Passenger Transportation Plan (PTP) and Transportation Improvement Program (TIP Transit Element) Amendments and Administrative Modifications – Staff will present the following amendments and administrative modifications to the FY 2011 – 2014 PTP and TIP. (Action Items)

Amendments

1. Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) extended hours of service for Sioux City Transit System needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$64,500 with \$32,250 Federal participation (JARC 5316) in FY 2011
2. New Freedom enhanced ADA services extended hours for Sioux City Transit System needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$5,000 with \$2,500 Federal participation (New Freedom 5317) in FY 2011

Administrative Modifications

1. JARC program with Stream in Sergeant Bluff for Sioux City Transit System needs to be programmed for a total cost of \$19,300 with \$8,000 Federal participation (JARC 5316) in FY 2011
2. Replace one 35' HD ADA bus with 4 cameras (Bus #1077) for Sioux City Transit System needs to be programmed for a total cost of \$191,100 with \$158,613 Federal Participation (New Freedom 5317) in FY 2011
