- II. 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan Amendments (LRTP) – Staff will present the following amendments to the 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan. (Action Items)
  1. 19<sup>th</sup> Street (Casselman Street to Riverside Blvd) in Sioux City needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$1,200,000 with full Federal participation (Stimulus II) in FY 2010.
  2. Villa Avenue (John Street to ½ block east of Panoah Street) in Sioux City needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$650,000 with full Federal participation (Stimulus II) in FY 2010.
  3. Pearl Street (4<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> Street) in Sioux City needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$2,400,000 with \$766,049 Federal participation (Stimulus II) in FY 2010.
  4. K45 (Sergeant Bluff city line to MPO Boundary) in Woodbury County needs to be programmed at a total estimated cost of \$625,000 with \$550,000 Federal participation (Stimulus II) in FY 2010.
  5. S. Lewis Boulevard (Recreation complex to south end Warrior Rd) in Sergeant Bluff needs to be programmed at a total estimated cost of \$820,000 with \$600,000 Federal participation (Stimulus II) in FY 2010.
