Administrative Modification

1. Interstate 29 Reconstruction (Iowa DOT) in Sioux City needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$33,237,000 with \$29,913,000 Federal participation in FY 2011; \$38,716,000 with \$34,844,000 Federal participation in FY 2012; \$35,798,000 with \$32,218,000 Federal participation in FY 2013, and \$77,972,000 with \$70,175,000 Federal participation in FY 2014

2. New Freedom enhanced ADA services extended hours for Sioux City Transit System needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$5,000 with \$2,500 Federal participation (New Freedom 5317) in FY 2011

Administrative Modifications

1. JARC program with Stream in Sergeant Bluff for Sioux City Transit System needs to be programmed for a total cost of \$19,300 with \$8,000 Federal participation (JARC 5316) in FY 2011
2. Replace one 35' HD ADA bus with 4 cameras (Bus #1077) for Sioux City Transit System needs to be programmed for a total cost of \$191,100 with \$158,613 Federal Participation (New Freedom 5317) in FY 2011
